Guest Speaker: Dr. Donald Jud, Ph.D.

Dr. G. Donald Jud is Professor Emeritus and Research Fellow in the Office of Business and Economics Research at the Bryan School of Business and Economics at UNCG. He has taught courses in finance, real estate, and economics. Dr. Jud received his Ph.D. from the University of Iowa. He is author of over 80 academic articles and three books, including *Inflation and the Use of Indexing* and the *Desktop Encyclopedia of Banking*.

The past year has presented the nation with a once in a 100-year financial tsunami that is wiping out financial institutions, weakening domestic economic growth, and depressing the world economy. Dr. Jud will provide us with a comprehensive analysis of current trends and future prospects for the national economy.
